

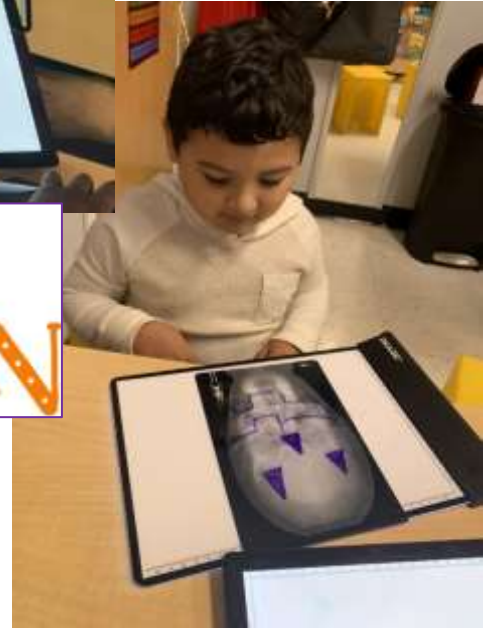

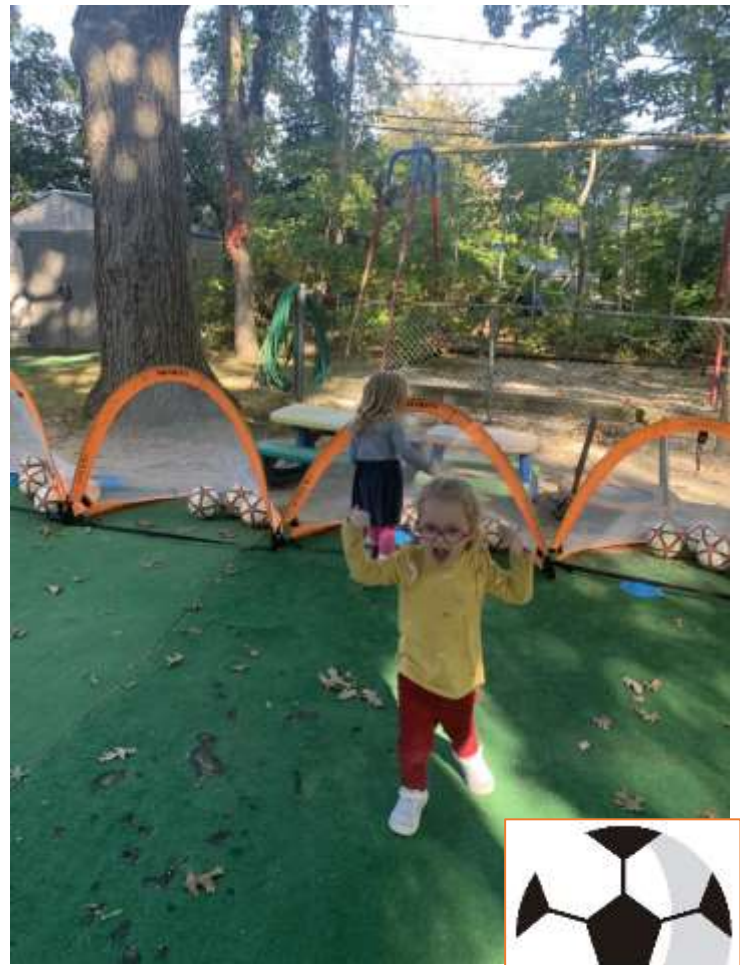
In STEM, we put on our firefighter hats & put out “fires” to save the numbers! We also used community helper felt board pieces to build our community.
